SUMMARY

Figure 1 shows Okayama Castle. Since Okayama Castle was built in 1597, it has acted as the foundation for Okayama City's development [1], [2]. Its exterior consisting of long, black shitami-itabari style wooden planks has earned it the nickname of "Crow Castle". Once a Japanese national treasure, the castle tower (tenshukaku) was burned down due to war damage during World War II. However, the castle tower with three strata and six stories has since been rebuilt. From the top of the tower, visitors can gaze upon the streets of Okayama City and Okayama Korakuen Garden located across the river.
